


9. Embargoed Areas

Orange – Middle & Long
Yellow – Relay (Full information will be provided in Bulletin 3)
Blue – Sprint & Super-Sprint Relay

With reference to the IOF Competition Rules, the listed areas are embargoed for all potential WDOC, WJDOC, DMOWC team members as well as coaches, team leaders and other persons that may be able to give information to the team members. It is permissible to pass through the embargoed areas using paved public roads any means of transportation (car, bike, foot etc.)

SPRINT & SUPER-SPRINT RELAY - 30th + 31st AUGUST



The sprint and super-sprint relay events will be competed in a newly drawn area, never used in any competition or trainings. The events are close by the famous **Avicii Arena** (former known as Stockholm Globe Arena) and **Tele2 Arena**, which the WDOC23 official logo are inspired from.















Competition: Sprint individual Date & time: 30 August ~15.00 Organizing club: IFK Enskede

Description of the terrain

The area is built up in the 1980's by three floor buildings mostly formed in squares around courtyards with walking paths and children's playgrounds. There are almost no cars except for a larger street which must be crossed at certain passages marked on the map.

The area has never been mapped although it is a very interesting sprint-area where you must be a fast map reader. It is important to keep in mind what to do next if you like to run fast, which is possible since there is almost no climb at all in this area.

The surface contains around 90 % asphalt and 10 % grass.


Competition: Super-Sprint Relay Date & time: 31 August ~ 15.00 Organizing club: IFK Enskede

Description of the terrain

Compared to the individual sprint area this one is quite hilly. The buildings are much more scattered in this neighbourhood much more characterized by the nature with a lot of trees and slopes in between. You can keep high speed since you probably will find it quite easy. The challenge is instead finding the best runnable way between these buildings and of course to be alert in all three laps!

The surface contains around 60-70 % asphalt and 30-40 % gras and gravel.








LONG & MIDDLE - 2nd & 3rd September

The Middle- and Long-distance events will be held in the very northern part of Stockholm region, part of **Bromseby Nature Reserve**. The competition will take place in parallel with **Stockholm Regional Championship** in Middle- & Long-distance competitions expected to gather more than 1000 competitors.















Competitions: Long & Middle

Dates & times: 2 September ~ 9.00 (long) & 3 September ~ 10.00 (middle)

Organizing club: Attunda OK

Description of the terrain

The competition area is mainly pine forest with sparse occurrence of roads and paths, with good runnability mixed with obstructed runnability. The area contains marshes in various sizes and runnability.

Elevation is low steepness with some occasional higher elevations with passable cliffs occurrences.

RELAY – 4th September (place not finalized yet)



10. Spectator races

We are also offering spectator races in sprint, middle & long distances. Spectators, officials etc. who wish to run an open course in different levels - very easy, easy, medium-hard & hard). Each competition-fee is around 15€ and should be paid upon place by cash.

The courses **ARE NOT** same as WDOC, WDJOC or DMOWC but in same area and same map.

31st August – Sprint individual (after WDOC & DMOWC Super-Sprint Relay) 2nd September – Long (parallelly with WDOC & DMOWC) 3rd September – Middle (parallelly with WDOC & DMOWC)

NOTE: The accommodations are prioritizing to participants for WDOC, WDJOC & DMOWC. We aim to offer spectators accommodation, transport etc. as well but only after participants in WDOC, WDJOC & DMOWC are done with their reservations.

11. Training Package - 2-4 June 2023

We're happy to offer you all a **Training Package** between 2nd thru 4th June 2023. The package aims to offer all participating countries the possibility to train in the relevant terrains close to each competition areas. 15. Registration fee for ICSD

Every athletes & officials for WDOC & WDJOC must pay a registration fee to ICSD with the amount of **40 \$ (US DOLLAR).** ICSD is responsible to send out invoices to all federations after the final Name Registration form.

NOTE: DMOWC athletes & officials doesn't need to pay the ICSD registration fee!

16. Competition Rules

In case of disagreement in the interpretation of the Rules and Regulations, the English text shall prevail. Unforeseen incidents not covered by the Rules and Regulations shall be dealt with as follows:
 - a) cases of a general nature will be resolved in accordance with ICSD Regulations, ICSD General Technical Rules and this Orienteering Technical Regulations.
 - b) technical questions related to competition rules shall be resolved according to the IOF Rules and Regulations.
 - c) only athletes who comply with the ICSD Regulations are entitled to take part in the ICSD Orienteering competitions.
- 16.2 The orienteering competitions of the Deaf Masters Orienteering World Cup will be conducted in accordance with the Technical Regulations DMOWC 2023.

17. Participants and Classes

WDOC & WJDOC:

Each National Federation may enter a maximum number of twelve (12) competitors – six (6) men and six (6) women.

Sprint Distance - each nation may enter three (3) women and three (3) men. **Middle Distance** - each nation may enter three (3) women and three (3) men. **Long Distance** - each nation may enter three (3) women and three (3) men.













WDOC:

Relay - each nation may enter **one** (1) **women's team** and **one** (1) **men's team**, each consisting of **three** (3) **team members**. Incomplete teams and teams with runners from more than one Federation are not allowed.

Super-Sprint Relay - each nation may enter **one** (1), each consisting of **two** (2) **mixed team members**. Incomplete teams and teams with runners from more than one Federation are not allowed.

WJDOC:

Relay - each nation may enter **one** (1) women's team and **one** (1) men's team, each consisting of **two** (2) **mixed team members**. Incomplete teams and teams with runners from more than one Federation are not allowed.

DMOWC:

Individual Events (**Sprint**, **Middle** and **Long**) - there is no limit on athletes from each National Federation from clubs.

Super-Sprint Relay will be conducted in the spirit in the form of mixed teams of different classes men and women from different participating clubs, more details about Super-Sprint Relay in DMOWC will be provided in the final Bulletin depending on number of participants.

Relay will be mixed teams of 2 runners in each team, the teams will be decided after final entries depending om number of participants registered.
